

Moray Game Jam – Disclaimers/Guidelines for application

- All team members must be 16 years of age or over.
- Participants are to bring their own equipment for use at the Moray Game Jam, relevant equipment should include:
 - Hardware
 - 3 metre network cables
 - Relevant Software
- Whilst on UHI Moray premises safety of participant's equipment will be their own responsibility, the organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred whilst attending the Moray Game Jam.
- To meet safety regulations, participant's equipment should be unplugged when not in use. However, equipment may be left running on its battery.
- All participants should register on arrival to obtain an ID card, which should be worn at all times during the event, to aid security and Health & Safety requirements.
- Medical needs and emergency details should be provided for each participant during registration.
- Specific areas of UHI Moray premises and IT facilities are being made available for the Moray Game Jam, participants are asked to respect restrictions advised at registration to aid event security and participant safety. A breach of the advised restrictions, such as entering unauthorised areas or consuming alcohol on the premises could result in a participant(s) being asked to leave the Moray Game Jam.
- There will be photography and filming for promotional use during the event, if participants do not wish to have their image used, please make this known to the staff at the Game Jam. You will be asked for permission when completing your application.
- Any software being used on UHI Moray premises for the Moray Game Jam should be licensed appropriately, unless a free or trial version is in use.
- Accommodation provided is limited to a space to sleep. Participants need to bring their own sleeping equipment.
